<b>Purpose of Form:</b>	To allow a parent who has been awarded periods of physical placement to seek enforcement of a physical placement order.
<b>Who Completes It:</b>	The party who seeks to enforce a physical placement order. This person shall be identified as the petitioner, regardless of whether that person was the petitioner or respondent in the underlying action.
<b>Distribution of Form:</b>	Court and petitioner for service on respondent.

<b>Comments:</b>	<p>Court has to hold hearing within 30 days.</p> <p>Although §767.471(3)(c), Wis. Stats., requires the acceptance of any legible motion, the committee believes that it is appropriate to have a standard form available for use so that all information required by §767.471(a) and (b), Wis. Stats., is provided.</p> <p>§767.471(3)(d), Wis. Stats., provides that the petition shall be filed under the principal action under which the periods of physical placement were awarded.</p>
