Comments: This order follows a district attorney's filing a petition to compel a person to provide a biological specimen to the state crime laboratories for deoxyribonucleic acid analysis. The district attorney's petition, filed without fee, results in a civil case being opened. If the court determines the district attorney's petition satisfies certain conditions, this Order is issued requiring the person to appear in court or provide a biological specimen at the office of the county sheriff before the time of the hearing.
