convicted of engaging in repeated sexual assault of the same child under \$948.025(1) from engaging in an occupation or working as a volunteer involving primary and direct work or interaction with children 15 and

under.

Comments: 1997 Act 130 amended §948.13(2) and created (2m) to provide an

exemption and a procedure to request exemption from prohibitions against a person convicted of multiple sexual assaults of the same person from engaging in direct and primary contact with children age 15 and under through an occupation or in volunteer work. While the statute provides that a hearing "may" be held, RMC recommends that such a hearing be scheduled and noticed. The court may also order and examination of the petitioner. Notice to the district attorney who prosecuted petitioner is required, and the DA is required to notify the victim. The victim is allowed to make a statement at the hearing or in writing. The petitioner must prove he or she was 18 or younger at the time of the commission of the offenses, that the victim was at least 13 but not yet 16, and within 4 years of petitioner's age at the time of commission and that the prohibition

is not necessary to protect the public.
