2009 Wisconsin Act 28 expanded the criteria for requesting expunction of an adult conviction to include Class H and Class I felonies. Act 28 makes expunction mandatory in invasion of privacy cases (voyeurism) under §942.08(2)(b), (c), or (d) if the

defendant was under age 18 on the date of the offense.
