Purpose of Form:	Authorize temporary guardian of estate for a minor or incompetent.
Who Completes It:	Petitioner or attorney.
Who Signs It:	BY THE COURT: Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner. COURT SEAL.
Distribution of Form:	Court, Guardian and interested persons as required by statutes.
Accompanying Forms:	
New Form/Modification:	Modified; last update 11/18.
Modifications:	Added temporary guardian of the estate may not sell real estate or expend an amount in excess of \$2,000 unless specifically approved by the court and a bond ordered.
Comments:	There are separate forms for Letters for Guardianship of Person (GN-3200) and Estate (GN-3210) and Temporary Guardianship of the Person (GN-3260) and Estate (GN-3265) and Guardianship of a Person of a Minor (GN-3340) and Estate of a Minor (GN-3345).
