<b>Comments:</b>	<p>1997 Act 292 (Effective July 1, 1998) created §48.133, Wis. Statutes. This section gives the court jurisdiction over both an expectant mother and an unborn child if the unborn child is alleged to be in need of protection or services under that statute.</p> <p>Jurisdiction exists if it is alleged:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• the expectant mother habitually lacks self-control in the use of alcohol beverages, controlled substances or controlled substance analogs, and,</li><li>• the lack of self-control is exhibited to a severe degree, and,</li><li>• there is a substantial risk that the physical health of the child, both before and after birth, will be seriously affected or endangered unless the expectant mother receives prompt and adequate treatment for her lack of self-control.</li></ul> <p>The expectant mother can be either an adult or a juvenile for this section to apply.</p>
