

## FORM SUMMARY

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**Name of Form:** Consent Decree (In-Home Placement Only)

**Form Number:** JD-1784B

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**Statutory Reference:** §§48.32 and 938.32, Wisconsin Statutes

**Purpose of Form:** To record an agreement between the parties requiring certain actions or activities to be done in exchange for suspending formal proceedings. The court official approves the consent decree and orders the parties to comply with it.

**Who Completes It:** Court.

**Who Signs It:** **BY THE COURT:** Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner.

**Distribution of Form:** Court, Child – if 12 years or older/Juvenile, Child’s/Juvenile’s Guardian ad Litem/Adversary Counsel, Parents, Parents’ Attorney(s), Child’s/Juvenile’s Guardian/Legal Custodian, District Attorney/Corporation Counsel, and Caseworker.

**Accompanying Forms:** Generally none.

**New Form/Modification:** Modified; last update 05/18.

**Modifications:** Added distribution list.

**Comments:** This consent decree is only to be used for in-home placements. For out-of-home placements under a consent decree use form JD-1785, Consent Decree (Out-of-Home Placement Only).
