and must be signed and sworn to be true by 3 adult persons, at least one of whom has personal knowledge of the conduct of the subject

individual.

Distribution of Form: The original document must be filed by the corporation counsel

with the probate court for the county where the individual is present or the county of the individual's legal residence. A copy must be provided to the subject individual at the time he or she is taken into custody for detention at a treatment facility. An additional copy must be provided to the detention facility at the

time of admission of the individual.

Accompanying Forms: Generally none, unless petitioner adds pages with additional factual

allegations.
