This rule proposal comes before the court upon the petition of Chief Justice Shirley S. Abrahamson of the Wisconsin Supreme Court. Petitioner proposes that the supreme court amend Supreme Court Rule 99.01(4)(e) to update and correct a statutory citation contained in the rule chapter. A memorandum in support of this petition accompanies this filing.

This petition is filed pursuant to the supreme court's administrative authority over all courts conferred by Article VII, s. 3 of the Wisconsin Constitution.

Petitioner proposes that SCR 99.01(4)(e) be amended to read as follows:

SCR 99.01 (4) Time, how computed.

(e) "Legal holiday" as used in this rule means any statewide legal holiday provided in section 757.17 995.20 of the statutes. When an act is permitted to be done by the use of the postal service, and the last day within the time prescribed by law for performing the act falls on a legal public holiday under federal law, or other holiday designated by the president such that the postal services does not receive certified mail or make regular deliveries on that day, the day shall be considered a legal holiday for purposes of this rule.
