I write to comment on the response of Attorney Rose to my previous comments.

The disclosure in *Disciplinary Proceedings Against Harman*, 2001 WI 71 would appear to be permissible if the petition is adopted; the information could be disclosed pursuant to subparagraph (c)(2) as having been already revealed.

In addition, the fact in *Harman* that the public record had been destroyed is not persuasive. The harm to the former client occurs regardless whether information previously revealed or previously contained in a public record remains available in that record.
