New Laws

Act 75 – Underage Tobacco Sales Compliance Checks. Allows municipal law enforcement agencies to conduct unannounced underage tobacco sales compliance checks of retail establishments under certain specified conditions. Former law only allowed law enforcement agencies that had contracted with the Department of Health and Family Services to conduct such compliance checks. Became effective April 30, 2002.

Act 84 – OAR/OAS. The final section of Act 84, pertaining to persons arrested for Operating While Revoked (OAR) or Operating While Suspended (OAS) became effective May 1, 2002. As a result, all Operating After Revocation charges are criminal and all Operating While Suspended charges are civil.

These changes are reflected on pages 23 and 75 of the 2002 Revised Uniform State Traffic Deposit Schedule.

Oath Of Office Reminder

Our office is still missing the Oaths of Office from a number of our Municipal Judges. Please remember that Sec. 755.03, Wis. Stats. states that "No Judge may act as such until his or her oath and bond have been filed as required by s. 19.01(4) c and the requirements of sub (2) have been complied with."

We have also noted that a number of the oaths we have received do not contain the specific language prescribed by Sec. 755.02 & Sec. 757.02(1), Wis. Stats. The proper oath is as set forth below:

State of Wisconsin,
County of . . .

I, the undersigned, who have been elected (or appointed) to the office of Municipal Court Judge, but have not yet entered upon the duties thereof, do solemnly swear that I will support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of Wisconsin; that I will administer justice without respect to persons and will faithfully and

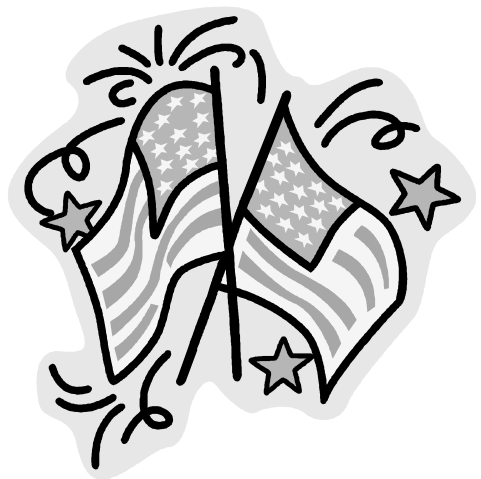
impartially discharge the duties of said office to the best of my ability. So help me God.
