Who Completes It: Petitioner, petitioner's attorney, or court official.

Distribution of Form: SUMMONS & TPR PETITION:

Court, Child - if 12 years old or older, Child's Guardian ad Litem/Adversary Counsel, Parents, Non-adjudicated father who filed a declaration of paternal interest, Alleged father(s), Person who has lived in a familial relationship with the child and may be the father, Guardian/Legal Custodian, Any other person to whom notice is required to be given by Wis. Stats. Ch. 822

(UCCJEA) - excluding foster parents, Tribe and Indian Custodian.

when served.
