Purpose of Form: Motion to transfer a proceeding involving an out-of-home placement of, or termination of parental rights to, an Indian child from a circuit court to a tribal court.

Who Completes It: Petitioner (parent, Indian custodian, or representative from the Indian child's/juvenile's tribe) or the petitioner's attorney (if any).

Distribution of Form: Court, Child's/Juvenile's Guardian ad Litem/Adversary Counsel, Parents, Parents' Attorney(s), Child's/Juvenile's Guardian/Legal Custodian, District Attorney/Corporation Counsel, Caseworker, Tribe, and Indian Custodian.

Comments: Upon the motion of the Indian child's parent, Indian custodian, or tribe, the circuit court shall transfer any Indian child custody proceeding involving an out-of-home placement of, or termination of parental rights to, an Indian child to tribal court unless: a parent objects to the transfer, the tribe does not have a tribal court, the tribal court declines jurisdiction, or the circuit court determines that good cause exists to deny the transfer under §§48.028(3)(c)3. or 938.028(3)(c)3., Wisconsin Statutes.
