Re: Rule Petition 10-08, a petition to establish a right to counsel in civil cases

Dear Ms. Rich:

With respect to Rule Petition 10-08, the Court of Appeals takes no position on the petition. It should be observed that under WIS. STAT. RULE 809.85, an attorney appointed by a lower court in a case appealed to the Court of Appeals shall continue to act in the same capacity in the Court of Appeals until the Court of Appeals relieves the attorney. This has been interpreted to mean that once a notice of appeal is filed, the circuit court no longer has discretion to terminate court-appointed counsel. *Roberta Jo W. v. Leroy W.*, 218 Wis. 2d 225, 241, 578 N.W.2d 185 (1998). Should the Supreme Court decide to proceed on Rule Petition 10-08, the Court of Appeals requests that a study committee be formed and that the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals, or his designate, and the Chief Staff Attorney be members. It will be important to assess how the appointment requirement will work at the appellate level.
