
Dear Ms. Reiff:

Pursuant to this Court's January 10, 2021 Order regarding the submission of uniform maps, the Citizen Mathematicians and Scientists hereby enclose for filing PDF copies of their proposed congressional, senate, and assembly maps.

For each of their congressional, senate, and assembly maps, the Citizen Mathematicians and Scientists enclose a statewide map, as well as Madison, Milwaukee, Eau Claire/Chippewa Falls, and Green Bay/Fox Cities area maps. Consistent with the parties' agreement, each map was produced by the Wisconsin Legislative Technology Services Bureau, and prepared in two ways. The first depicts district lines and numbers. The second depicts district lines, district numbers, county boundaries, and (in the case of area maps) municipal boundary information. The municipal boundary information was drawn from the U.S. Census Bureau's TIGER 2020 municipal layer and therefore reflects changes to municipal borders that have occurred since 2011. The paper originals, transparency originals, and 17 copies of each uniform map will be delivered by 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, January 18.
