Purpose of Form:	Court order to enter a money judgment based upon noncompliance of a defendant(s).
Who Completes It:	The plaintiff(s) or plaintiff’s attorney.
Who Signs It:	BY THE COURT: Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner. THIS IS A FINAL ORDER FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPEAL IF SIGNED BY A CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE.
Distribution of Form:	Original will be filed with the court after it has been signed and notarized.
Accompanying Forms:	None.
New Form/Modification:	Modified; last update 10/07.
Modifications:	Added language that the court vacates the order for dismissal and Circuit Court Commissioner to signature area. Updated Wambolt language.
Comments:	Split for eFiling, 05/16. If either party believes there has a violation of a written agreement between themselves, they may request the court to take appropriate action. If the violation is by a party who owes money, and the amount of money is agreed to, the court may simply be asked to enter a judgment for the money damages plus costs (using SC-5420V). If the violation is such that there are no money damages or that the parties agree that the court should first hold a hearing to determine whether there has been a violation or determine what the appropriate relief should be, the court would be asked to conduct a hearing and make the appropriate determination (using SC-5410V).
About this Form:	This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court’s Office. As a <i>pro se</i> voluntary form, its use is NOT mandatory but it is required to be accepted and distributed by the circuit courts of the State of Wisconsin.
