Modifications:	Removed “Defendant” from “Respondent/Defendant” statements; added “person who filed” to Petitioner/Child section on first page; reworded field that defines relationship between child and respondent; combined biological, adoptive, and step parent checkboxes; updated distribution list.
Comments:	No filing fee or sheriff’s fee can be charged to the petitioner. However, it can be collected from the respondent if he/she is convicted of violating the temporary restraining order or injunction. This form is available in Spanish and Hmong.
