Jamie L. Schrank, by Attorney Leonard D. Kachinsky, is pursuing these consolidated appeals under the no-merit procedure set forth in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.32 (2021-22).<sup>1</sup> By order dated August 15, 2023, we directed Attorney Kachinsky to file a supplemental no-merit report addressing whether the jury instructions relating to Schrank's two convictions for chronic child neglect in Manitowoc County Circuit Court case No. 2018CF504 were erroneous. He now

informs this court that he has determined there is an issue of arguable merit to pursue by postconviction motion. Good cause is shown to dismiss these appeals and extend the time to file a postconviction motion pursuant to RULE 809.30.

Based on the foregoing,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and the no-merit appeals are dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time to file a postconviction motion is extended to sixty days from the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
