Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or

authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

Attorney Steven Zaleski, as appointed counsel for C.C., has filed a no-merit report

pursuant to WIS. STAT. RULE 809.107(5m). Counsel provided C.C. with a copy of the report, and

both counsel and this court advised her of her right to file a response. C.C. has not responded.

The court concludes that these cases are appropriate for summary disposition. See WIS. STAT.

RULE 809.21. After an independent review of the records, the court concludes that the records

do not show arguable merit to any issue that could be raised on appeal.

As to all five children, the circuit court found C.C. in default after she failed to appear at

an early hearing in the case. C.C. did not move to vacate the default finding, although she was in

contact with counsel at a later time. Before disposition, the circuit court conducted a prove-up at

which it heard testimony in support of the alleged grounds of failure to assume parental

responsibility and continuing child in need of protection and services. The court found that the

grounds were proven.

The court's finding of default was consistent with applicable law such as Evelyn C.R. v.

Tykila S., 2001 WI 110, 246 Wis. 2d 1, 629 N.W.2d 768. The evidence at the prove-up met the

necessary elements of the two alleged grounds for termination. There is no arguable merit to a

claim that the circuit court erred in finding C.C. in default at the grounds phase of the

proceeding.

The court then held a dispositional hearing, and concluded that termination of C.C.'s

parental rights was in the best interests of the children. The court considered the proper standard

and factors under WIS. STAT. § 48.426(2) and (3), did not consider improper factors, and reached

a reasonable result. An argument that the court erroneously exercised its discretion would lack

arguable merit.

The court's review of the record shows no other grounds to appeal.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the orders terminating parental rights are summarily affirmed. See

WIS. STAT. RULE 809.21.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Attorney Zaleski is relieved of further representation

of C.C. in these matters.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
