By order dated August 6, 2014, this court directed Attorney J. Dennis Thornton, appellate counsel for Adrian Williams, to file a supplemental no-merit report in these consolidated matters. Attorney Thornton now advises that, in his view, the case presents an arguably meritorious issue. Counsel therefore seeks voluntary dismissal of the no-merit proceedings and an extension of the deadline for pursuing postconviction relief in the circuit court. A no-merit proceeding is

appropriate only if counsel is convinced that an appeal would be wholly frivolous. *McCoy v. Court of Appeals*, 486 U.S. 429, 437 (1988). Accordingly, the court will grant the motion.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and these consolidated appeals are dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for filing a postconviction motion or notice of appeal in these matters is extended through October 13, 2014. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a) (2011-12).
