Before Curley, P.J.

By order dated January 6, 2015, this court directed Attorney Gina Frances Bosben, appellate counsel for Jonathon F. Lincoln, to file a supplemental no-merit report in this matter. Attorney Bosben now advises that, in her view, the case presents an arguably meritorious issue. Counsel therefore seeks voluntary dismissal of the no-merit appeal and an extension of the deadline for pursuing postconviction relief in the circuit court. A no-merit proceeding is appropriate only if counsel is convinced that an appeal would be wholly frivolous. *McCoy v. Court of Appeals*, 486 U.S. 429, 437 (1988). Accordingly, the court will grant the motion.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and this appeal is dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for filing a postconviction motion or notice of appeal is extended through April 6, 2015. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a) (2011-12).
