Before Kloppenburg, P.J., Higginbotham and Blanchard, JJ.

In response to this court's April 18, 2016 order directing appointed counsel to obtain, file, and review the video interview of the victim, Attorney Steven D. Grunder indicates that he believes there is arguable merit to challenging the admission of the victim's statement and that the appellant wishes to pursue that issue. Accordingly, this appeal is converted to a merits appeal. The no-merit report is rejected and the "NM" suffix is removed from the case number. It appears that a motion to supplement the record may be necessary. The time for filing the motion is set by this order. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and appointed counsel's motion to withdraw is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appeal is converted to a merits appeal; if a motion to supplement the record is necessary, the motion shall be filed by June 30, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appellant's brief shall be filed within sixty days of the date of this order or, if a motion to supplement the record is granted, within forty days of the date the supplement to the record is received, whichever is later.
