**Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).**

By order dated September 7, 2017, this court directed Attorney Carl W. Chesshir, appellate counsel for Jerry Slack, Jr., to file several items in this matter, including a supplemental no-merit report. Attorney Chesshir now requests voluntary dismissal of the no-merit appeal and an extension of appellate deadlines. The requests reflect that counsel believes the case presents

at least one arguably meritorious issue. A no-merit appeal is appropriate only if counsel is convinced that further postconviction proceedings would be wholly frivolous. *See McCoy v. Court of Appeals*, 486 U.S. 429, 437 (1988). Accordingly, the court will grant the relief requested.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and this appeal is dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for filing a postconviction motion or notice of appeal is extended through December 4, 2017. *See WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a)* (2015-16).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
