2016AP1523-CRNM State of Wisconsin v. Jamaal T. Shellie (L.C. # 2014CF71)

Before Brennan, P.J., Brash and Dugan, JJ.

Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

By order dated December 14, 2017, this court directed Attorney Sara Heinemann Roemaat, appellate counsel for Jamaal T. Shellie, to file a supplemental no-merit report in this matter. Attorney Roemaat now advises that the case presents at least one arguably meritorious issue and requests voluntary dismissal of the no-merit appeal and an extension of appellate

deadlines. A no-merit appeal is appropriate only if counsel is convinced that further postconviction proceedings would be wholly frivolous. *See McCoy v. Court of Appeals*, 486 U.S. 429, 437 (1988). Accordingly, the court will grant the relief requested.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and this appeal is dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for filing a postconviction motion or notice of appeal is extended through March 5, 2018. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a) (2015-16).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
