By order dated October 24, 2017, the court directed Attorney Thomas J. Erickson,

appellate counsel for Allen Tanell Gregory, to file a supplemental no-merit report in this matter.

Attorney Erickson subsequently advised that in his opinion further postconviction proceedings

would have arguable merit, and he requested voluntary dismissal of the appeal and an extension

of appellate deadlines. A no-merit appeal is appropriate only if counsel is convinced that further

postconviction proceedings would be wholly frivolous. See McCov v. Court of Appeals, 486

U.S. 429, 437 (1988). Accordingly, the court will grant the relief requested. Counsel does not

state how much time is required to prepare the postconviction submission. The court will

establish an appropriate deadline.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and this appeal is dismissed without

prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for filing a postconviction motion or

notice of appeal is extended through March 12, 2018. See WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a) (2015-

16).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
