**Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).**

Our May 8, 2018 order identified an issue with arguable merit in Antoniyo Harris's WIS. STAT. RULE 809.32 (2015-16) no-merit appeal from judgments convicting him of possessing cocaine with intent to deliver and resisting/obstructing. In response to our May 8 order, appointed appellate counsel has provided this court with a copy of a circuit court motion seeking plea withdrawal. From counsel's response, we determine that Harris desires to dismiss this

appeal and seek postconviction relief in the circuit court pursuant to RULE 809.30. Therefore, we reject the no-merit report and dismiss this appeal in favor of further proceedings in the circuit court pursuant to RULE 809.30. The time to file a postconviction motion is extended to July 27, 2018.

Upon the foregoing reasons,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appeal is dismissed in favor of further circuit court proceedings pursuant to WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time to file a WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30 postconviction motion is extended to July 27, 2018.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
