Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

By order dated July 16, 2018, this court directed Attorney Robert E. Haney, appellate counsel for Keith Allen Erickson, to file a supplemental no-merit report in these matters. Attorney Haney now requests voluntary dismissal of the no-merit appeals and an extension of appellate deadlines, stating that upon review of the transcripts, counsel has identified an arguably meritorious issue. A no-merit appeal is appropriate only if counsel is convinced that further

postconviction proceedings would be wholly frivolous. *See McCoy v. Court of Appeals*, 486 U.S. 429, 437 (1988). Accordingly, the court will grant the relief requested.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and these appeals are dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for filing a postconviction motion or notice of appeal is extended through the date twenty days after remittitur. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a) (2015-16).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
