Appointed appellate counsel has filed the response required by our October 3, 2018 order noting issues with arguable merit in this WIS. STAT. RULE 809.32 (2015-16) no-merit appeal. Our October 3 order rejected the no-merit report and required appellate counsel to advise as to how this matter will proceed. Counsel now advises that a WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30 postconviction motion will be filed in the circuit court.
