Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

By prior order, this court questioned whether there would be arguable merit to a postconviction motion challenging the restitution ordered in this case. This court's order directed appointed counsel to review the issue and consult with the appellant, and then provide

this court with further input. Counsel now moves to extend the time to file a postconviction motion challenging the restitution award.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and this no-merit appeal is dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time to file a postconviction motion or notice of appeal is extended to sixty days from the date of this order.
