2019AP1372-CRNM State of Wisconsin v. Curtis James Rumsey (L.C. # 2017CF2105)

Before Brash, P.J., Dugan and White, JJ.

Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

Appointed appellate counsel was ordered to file a supplemental no-merit report addressing potential issues identified in our review of the record but not addressed in the nomerit report. In response, appellate counsel indicates that a no-merit conclusion is no longer appropriate and that a postconviction motion should be filed in the circuit court. Accordingly, to return the matter to the circuit court for a postconviction motion we reject the no-merit report, dismiss the appeal, and extend the time under WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30(2)(h), for filing a postconviction motion.

Upon the foregoing reasons,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and Attorney Angela Conrad Kachelski's motion to be relieved of further representation of Curtis James Rumsey is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the no-merit appeal is dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time under WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30(2)(h) for filing a postconviction motion is extended to sixty days from remittitur. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
