2019AP79-CRNM State of Wisconsin v. Craig D. Miller (L.C. #2017CF443)

Before Neubauer, C.J., Reilly, P.J., and Gundrum, J.

Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

Attorney Ellen J. Krahn, appointed counsel for Craig D. Miller, previously filed a no-merit report seeking to withdraw as appellate counsel pursuant to WIS. STAT. RULE 809.32

(2017-18)¹ and *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). We identified an issue of potentially arguable merit, and we directed counsel to respond by filing a supplemental report, seeking dismissal, or responding in some other manner that counsel deemed appropriate. Counsel has now filed a notice of voluntary dismissal. Counsel states that Miller has informed her that he does not wish to pursue this potential issue and that he has directed her to dismiss his appeal instead. Counsel states that neither she nor Miller will take further action in this case.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appeal is dismissed pursuant to the appellant's notice of voluntary dismissal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
