**Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).**

By order dated September 30, 2020, this court directed Attorney Thomas J. Erickson, appellate counsel for Quentin L. Gillespie, to file a supplemental no-merit report in this matter. Attorney Erickson now advises that the case presents at least one arguably meritorious issue and requests voluntary dismissal of the no-merit appeal and an extension of appellate deadlines. A no-merit appeal is appropriate only if counsel is convinced that further postconviction

proceedings would be wholly frivolous. *See McCoy v. Court of Appeals*, 486 U.S. 429, 437 (1988). Accordingly, the court will grant the relief requested.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and this appeal is dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for filing a postconviction motion or notice of appeal is extended through December 11, 2020. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a) (2017-18).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
