Dreama Harvey, by newly retained counsel, has filed a motion seeking voluntary dismissal of this no-merit appeal pursuant to WIS. STAT. RULE 809.18 (2017-18), rejection of the no-merit report, and an extension of the time to file a postconviction motion or notice of appeal.

Harvey explains that she did not have the funds to retain private counsel at the time the no-merit report was submitted, but that she has now retained private counsel and wishes to pursue postconviction issues with the assistance of that counsel. She requests an extension of the time to file a postconviction motion or notice of appeal to June 18, 2021, due to the complexity of the case and the amount of time that counsel will need to review the significant record, including a jury trial with multiple expert witnesses. The motion shows good cause for the requested extension.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and that this appeal is dismissed without prejudice pursuant to the notice of voluntary dismissal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time to file a postconviction motion or notice of appeal is extended to June 18, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
