Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

In this no-merit case, counsel for the appellant has filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss the appeal, WIS. STAT. RULE 809.18, in favor of an extension of time to file a postconviction motion under RULE 809.30. Good cause exists for the requested relief.

The appellant has also filed a motion for relief seeking reinstatement of his right to file a postconviction motion. Because we grant counsel's motion, we deny the appellant's motion as moot. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appeal is dismissed pursuant to WIS. STAT. RULE 809.18.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time for filing a postconviction motion under WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30, is extended to June 13, 2022. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appellant's motion for relief is denied as moot.
