State of Wisconsin v. Vashon D. Bonds (L.C. # 2019CF5157)

Before Donald, P.J., Dugan and White, JJ.

Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

By order dated March 31, 2022, this court directed Attorney Annice Kelly, appellate counsel for Vashon D. Bonds, to file a supplemental no-merit report in this matter. Attorney Kelly now advises that the case presents at least one arguably meritorious issue and requests voluntary dismissal of the no-merit appeal and an extension of appellate deadlines under WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30 (2019-20). A no-merit appeal is appropriate only if counsel is convinced that further postconviction proceedings would be wholly frivolous. *See McCoy v. Court of Appeals*, 486 U.S. 429, 437 (1988). Accordingly, the court will grant the relief sought. To

accommodate this court's procedures for remittitur, the court will extend postconviction and

appellate deadlines for a period slightly longer than requested.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and this appeal is dismissed without

prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for filing a postconviction motion or

notice of appeal pursuant to WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30 is extended through June 17, 2022. See

WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
