2021AP1088-CRNM State of Wisconsin v. Jacquet D. Jenkins, Sr. (L.C. # 2017CF173)

Before Blanchard, P.J., Fitzpatrick, and Graham, JJ.

Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

Attorney Patricia Sommer, appointed counsel for Jacquet Jenkins, Sr., has filed a nomerit report seeking to withdraw as appellate counsel. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.32 (2019-20)¹ and *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738, 744 (1967). By prior order, we informed Attorney Sommer that we were unable to determine whether further proceedings would be wholly frivolous. We requested further input from counsel as to whether there would be arguable merit

to a claim that trial counsel was ineffective by failing to object to the State's sentencing

arguments on grounds that they amounted to a breach of the plea agreement.

Attorney Sommer now informs this court that she has researched the issue and consulted

with Jenkins. Counsel requests that this court dismiss the no-merit appeal so that counsel may

pursue a postconviction motion on Jenkins' behalf. Accordingly, we reject the no-merit report

and extend the time to file a postconviction motion.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and the no-merit appeal is

dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time to file a postconviction motion or notice of

appeal is extended to thirty days from the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
