State of Wisconsin v. Arthur Bernard Trammell (L.C. # 2020CF2377)

Before Brash, C.J., Donald, P.J., and White, J.

Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

By order dated December 6, 2021, this court directed Attorney Patricia A. FitzGerald, appellate counsel for Arthur Bernard Trammell, to file a supplemental no-merit report in this matter. Attorney FitzGerald now advises that, in her view, the case presents at least one arguably meritorious issue, and she requests voluntary dismissal of the no-merit appeal and an extension of appellate deadlines under WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30 (2019-20). A no-merit appeal is appropriate only if counsel is convinced that further postconviction proceedings would be wholly frivolous. See McCoy v. Court of Appeals, 486 U.S. 429, 437 (1988). Accordingly, the court

will grant the relief sought. To accommodate this court's procedures for remittitur, the court will

extend postconviction and appellate deadlines for a period somewhat longer than requested.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and this appeal is dismissed without

prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for Trammell to file a postconviction

motion or notice of appeal pursuant to WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30 is extended through the date

sixty days after remittitur of this matter. See WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
