2018AP1582-CRNM State of Wisconsin v. London D. White (L.C. # 2016CF656)

Before Gundrum, P.J., Grogan and Lazar, JJ.

Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

Carl W. Chesshir, appointed counsel for London D. White, filed a no-merit report seeking to withdraw as appellate counsel. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.32 (2021-22)¹ and *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738, 744 (1967). By prior order, we directed Attorney Chesshir to file a supplemental no-merit report with respect to two issues. He now informs this court that he has determined that there is an issue of arguable merit to pursue by postconviction motion. Good

cause is shown to dismiss this appeal and reinstate the time to file a postconviction motion pursuant to WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30.

Next, we address a letter the defendant filed with this court on February 10, 2023, before Attorney Chesshir asked this court to dismiss the appeal so he could pursue a postconviction motion. White asked this court to direct Attorney Chesshir to provide him with certain reports and records. Given that we are dismissing the no-merit appeal, we will take no action on White's request. We encourage White to discuss with Attorney Chesshir the documents he is seeking.

Upon the foregoing,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and the no-merit appeal is dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time to file a postconviction motion is extended to sixty days from the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this court will take no action on the defendant's February 10, 2023 letter to this court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
