2021AP2150-CRNM State of Wisconsin v. Deshawn Perry Moore (L.C. # 2018CF2280)

Before Brash, C.J., Dugan and White, JJ.

Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

Deshawn Perry Moore appeals the judgment entered after he pled guilty to felony murder.¹ His appellate counsel, Angela Conrad Kachelski, filed a no-merit report pursuant to Wis. Stat. Rule 809.32 (2021-22) and *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967).² Moore was advised of his right to file a response and has elected not to do so. Following a preliminary

review of the record, this court directed counsel to file a supplemental no-merit report addressing

the sufficiency of the guilty plea colloquy and whether there was a breach of the plea

negotiations by the State. The court indicated that in the alternative, if counsel identified an

issue of merit, she could move to dismiss the appeal and extend the time for filing a

postconviction motion.

Attorney Kachelski now advises that there are issues of merit in this case to be pursued.

She seeks to dismiss the no-merit appeal and extend the time for filing a postconviction motion.

Because a no-merit report is only appropriate if counsel is convinced that an appeal would be

wholly frivolous, McCoy v. Court of Appeals, 486 U.S. 429, 437 (1988), this court will grant

counsel's request for an extension of time to pursue a postconviction motion.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report in appeal No. 2021AP2150-CRNM is rejected

and the appeal is dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for Attorney Kachelski to file a

postconviction motion on Moore's behalf is extended to June 26, 2023. See WIS. STAT.

RULE 809.82(2)(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
