Appointed counsel in these consolidated no-merit appeals has moved to withdraw so that the appellant Brandon Dawson may proceed pro se. Counsel states in her motion that Dawson previously chose the option of a no-merit appeal, but that upon receiving a copy of the no-merit report, he informed counsel that he no longer wished to proceed with her as his lawyer.

In an order dated April 3, 2023, I informed Dawson regarding this court's independent

duty to determine that he is knowingly waiving his right to counsel. My order further informed

him regarding the no-merit process. The order also directed him to carefully consider all of the

information provided and to advise this court whether he still wished to discharge appointed

counsel.

Dawson has now responded, and he unequivocally states that he wishes to proceed pro se.

Based on his response, it appears that he may also wish to file a postconviction motion pursuant

to Wis. STAT. § 974.02 and Wis. STAT. Rule 809.30(2)(h). Accordingly, I now grant counsel's

motion to withdraw, dismiss these no-merit appeals, and reinstate and extend the time to file a

postconviction motion or notice of appeal under § 974.02 and RULE 809.30(2)(h).

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Attorney Susan Alesia is withdrawn as counsel.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that these no-merit appeals are dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time to file a postconviction motion or notice of

appeal is reinstated and extended to July 5, 2023.
