2022AP393-CRNM State of Wisconsin v. Shawna A. Guzik (L.C. #2019CF1164)

Before Gundrum, P.J., Neubauer and Lazar, JJ.

Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

Attorney John P. Mueller, as appointed counsel for Shawna A. Guzik, filed a no-merit report pursuant to WIS. STAT. RULE 809.32 (2021-22)¹ and *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Both counsel and this court advised Guzik of her right to file a response. Guzik has not responded. We conclude that this case is appropriate for summary disposition. See WIS. STAT.

RULE 809.21. After our independent review of the record, we conclude that there is no arguable merit to any issue that could be raised on appeal.

Guzik was convicted after she pled guilty to one count of possession of cocaine, as a second offense. As part of the plea deal, two additional counts were dismissed. At sentencing, the circuit court imposed a fine of \$200 plus costs and disbursements.

The no-merit report addresses (1) whether Guzik's pleas were entered knowingly, voluntarily, and intelligently; (2) whether the circuit court properly exercised its discretion at sentencing; and (3) whether the circuit court erred in denying Guzik's suppression motion. This court is satisfied that the no-merit report correctly analyzes the issues it raises as without merit, and we will not discuss them further.

Our review of the record discloses no other potential issues for appeal. Accordingly, this court accepts the no-merit report and discharges appellate counsel of the obligation to represent Guzik further in this appeal.

IT IS ORDERED that the judgment is summarily affirmed. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.21.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Attorney John P. Mueller is relieved from further representing Shawna A. Guzik in this appeal. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.32(3).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
