By order dated December 11, 2023, this court directed Attorney Pamela Moorshead, appellate counsel for Robert Lee Daniels, to file a supplemental no-merit report in this matter. Attorney Moorshead now requests voluntary dismissal of the no-merit appeal and an extension of appellate deadlines to permit the filing of a postconviction motion under WIS. STAT.

Pamela Moorshead Electronic Notice RULE 809.30(2)(h) (2021-22).¹ A no-merit appeal is appropriate only if counsel is convinced that further postconviction proceedings would be wholly frivolous. *See McCoy v. Court of Appeals*, 486 U.S. 429, 437 (1988). Accordingly, the court will grant the relief requested.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and this appeal is dismissed without prejudice. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.18(1).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for Daniels to file a postconviction motion or notice of appeal pursuant to WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30 is extended through the date thirty days after remittitur. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
