<b>Purpose of Form:</b>	To deny a petition for injunction or to dismiss a temporary restraining order/injunction in domestic abuse, individual at risk, harassment, or child abuse actions.
<b>Who Completes It:</b>	Court.
<b>Who Signs It:</b>	<b>BY THE COURT:</b> Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner. <b>THIS IS A FINAL ORDER FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPEAL IF SIGNED BY A CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE.</b>
<b>Distribution of Form:</b>	Court, copy to petitioner, respondent, and law enforcement agency acting as repository for injunctions and Department of Justice (if an injunction has been previously granted and is now being vacated).
<b>Accompanying Forms:</b>	If the petitioner is requesting a dismissal, or the parties are stipulating to a dismissal, some document evidencing the request will usually be provided to the court and may be attached to the order.
<b>New Form/Modification:</b>	Modification; last update 11/12.
<b>Modifications:</b>	Added in the Orders option that the Petition for Temporary Restraining Order is denied and Other.
<b>Comments:</b>	This form is to be used when a court official dismisses a temporary restraining order or an injunction: 1) At an injunction hearing; or 2) When a party requests a dismissal after an injunction has already been granted. This form should not be used as a dismissal order for dismissing or denying a temporary restraining order. If a party wants a de novo review of a court commissioner's decision, file a Motion for De Novo Hearing on a Temporary Restraining Order of Injunction (CV-503) form. Any order remains in effect until the circuit court judge in the de novo hearing issues a final order.
<b>About this Form:</b>	This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court's Office and a mandate of the Wisconsin Judicial Conference.
