Name of Form: Temporary Order Without Minor Children

Form Number: FA-4127VB

Statutory Reference: §§767.225 and 767.34, Wisconsin Statutes

Benchbook Reference:

Purpose of Form: Temporary court order for the parties in an action for a divorce or legal separation without minor children to agree on how various issues such as asset allocation, debt payments, maintenance payments, and similar matters will be handled while the action is pending.

Who Completes It: Court.

Who Signs It: **BY THE COURT:** Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner.

Distribution of Form: Court; copies would generally be retained by both of the parties and Family Court Commissioner.

Accompanying Forms: Although none are necessarily required, there may be schedules attached listing property, debts, or other information that doesn't fit on the form. Financial disclosure statements may also be attached as needed.

New Form/Modification: Modification; last update 02/10.

Modification: Incorporated same sex divorce language, added "except as follows" in #1. of orders and updated prohibited acts.

Comments: Split for eFiling, 05/16.

This form should not be used if the parties have minor children. Form FA-4126A/B, Stipulation for Temporary Order with Minor Children, should be used instead. This form is very inclusive and may include provisions that are not relevant to a particular situation. If a provision is not relevant, it should be marked accordingly.

About this Form: This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court's Office.

As a *pro se* form, its use is NOT mandatory but it is required to be accepted and distributed by the circuit courts of the State of Wisconsin.
