

## FORM SUMMARY

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**Name of Form:** Request for Court-Ordered Mediation

**Form Number:** FA-4134V

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**Statutory Reference:** §767.405 and 807.05, Wisconsin Statutes

**Benchbook Reference:**

**Purpose of Form:** A party who wants to have issues concerning a legal custody or physical placement situation may use this form to request an order from the court that would require the parties to participate in mediation of those issues.

**Who Completes It:** The party seeking the mediation.

**Distribution of Form:** Court. A copy would be served on the other parties.

**Accompanying Forms:** Although none are specifically required, it may be best practice to attach a copy of any existing court order that covers the custody or placement issue.

**New Form/Modification:** Modification; last update 10/06.

**Modification:** Incorporated same sex divorce language. Added party requesting mediation and relationship to child(ren). Added in Understandings that a party may need to file a motion before further court proceedings will be scheduled if parties are not able to settle disagreements in mediation.

**Comments:** A specific form ordering the mediation has not been prepared because each court usually has its own order.

**About this Form:** This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court's Office.

**As a *pro se* form, its use is NOT mandatory but it is required to be accepted and distributed by the circuit courts of the State of Wisconsin.**
