Name of Form: Stipulation Dismissing Divorce/Legal Separation

Purpose of Form: If the parties decide to dismiss the action, this form is used by the parties to sign the stipulation to that effect. It also provides the Order section for the court's signature.

Who Completes It: The parties would complete and sign the document and present it to the court for signature.

Distribution of Form: Original will be filed with the court. A copy should be provided on the other parties. A copy should be given to Family Court Commissioner and Child Support Agency (if there are minor children).

Accompanying Forms: None.

New Form/Modification: Modified; last update 11/13.

Modification: Incorporated same sex divorce language. Added dismissal of case does not relieve party of obligations for GAL, mediation, custody or any other court ordered costs or fees and "PARTIES MUST INCLUDE A PROPOSED ORDER THAT WILL ONLY BECOME ENFORCEABLE IF SIGNED BY A CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE OR CIRCUIT COURT COMMISSIONER."
