Purpose of Form:	To appoint a Full, Limited, or Temporary Guardian of the child and issue letters of guardianship and dispositional order appointing a guardian for an Indian child.
Who Completes It:	Court: Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner. This is a final order for the purpose of appeal.
Distribution of Form:	Court; copies to the child – if 12 years or older, child’s parents, child’s guardian, child’s legal custodian, child’s Guardian ad Litem/Adversary Counsel, Tribe, Indian Custodian, and any additional interested persons.
Accompanying Forms:	
New Form/Modification:	Modification; last update 10/25.
Modifications:	Added “This includes educational decision-making authority.” to the legal custody duty and authority within the full and limited guardianships.
Comments:	<p>To order Minor Guardianship of the Estate, use form GN-3330.</p> <p>For Dispositional Order Appointing an Emergency Guardian, use form JN-1521.</p> <p>The court may appoint co-guardians of the person for a child, subject to any conditions that the court imposes. Unless the court orders otherwise, any decision concerning the child must be concurred in by all co-guardians or is void. Wis. Stat. § 48.9795 (2)(b)(4). If co-guardians are ordered, both names shall be included on the order.</p>
