Name of Form: **Petition in Juvenile Court for Temporary Restraining Order and/or Petition and Motion for Injunction Hearing (Harassment - 30711)**

Purpose of Form: Petition in juvenile court initiating an action for a TRO/final injunction in harassment matters.

Who Completes It: Petitioner

Distribution of Form: Court and parties.

Accompanying Forms: Generally none unless the petitioner adds pages with additional factual allegations.

New Form/Modification: Modified; last update 05/16.

Modifications: Clarified that the “protected person” be referred to as “petitioner”. Deleted “” prior to setting a time for a hearing on the petition. Deleted notary section and added a declaration statement. Deleted “circuit” from clerk of court in the Service on Respondent section.

Comments: Available in Spanish.

If the TRO is denied, but the petitioner still wishes to have an injunction hearing, use form CV-449. If either a petitioner a respondent wishes to request a de novo review of a circuit court commissioner’s decision in a TRO or an injunction, use form CV-503.

CV-406 (Temporary Restraining Order and Notice of Injunction Hearing) and CV-407 (Injunction) are the forms used to grant relief.

Form JC-1693 should only be used when the respondent is a child or there is an existing CHIPS case involving the same child victim. CV-405 is the form to be used for harassment cases in civil court. It is to be used when an adult files against another adult, or when a parent, attorney, or other adult files on behalf of a child victim, and the respondent is an adult. Orders can now remain in effect for four years.
