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**Name of Form:** Acknowledgment of Notice of Rights and Obligations

**Purpose of Form:** A written notice to be provided to the child/juvenile and parents of their basic rights and obligations as well as the possibility of disclosure of personal information to victims.

**Who Completes It:** Intake worker. The form should be signed by juvenile/parents and placed in the file.

**Distribution of Form:**

1. Intake file.
2. Child/Juvenile/parents/legal custodian/legal guardian

**Accompanying Forms:** None

**New Form/Modification:** Modification, last update 5/00.

**Modifications:** Removed State of Wisconsin Circuit Court reference. Changed title of form (removed "possible disclosures"). Updated statutory references.

**Comments:** This form is intended to be handed out to the child/juvenile and/or parents at an intake conference or mailed when intake conference is not held and may be used at a custody intake.

1. Statutory references have been updated to include both ch. 48 and ch. 938.
2. References to "child" have been changed to "child/juvenile". A reference to "juvenile" refers to a ch. 938 cases only. A reference to "child/juvenile" refers to both ch. 48 and ch. 938 cases.

If the intake worker desires to add to the form the specific allegations, the white space to the right of the first checkboxes could be used for that purpose.

**About this Form:** This form was developed by the Wisconsin Juvenile Court Intake Forms Committee. It has been approved by the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Courts Office and a mandate of the Wisconsin Judicial Conference.
