<b>Distribution of Form:</b>	Original: Court If interest is in real property or debt secured by interest in real property, a certified copy or duplicate original must be recorded with the register of deeds.
<b>Accompanying Forms:</b>	Generally none.

<b>Modifications:</b>	Renumbered from PR-1818.
<b>Comments:</b>	Expanded file stamp/date area to 3" x 3" to accommodate the Register in Deeds statutory requirement for recorded documents (09/16).  Can be used in place of deeds to records transfer by virtue of probate to interested persons.
